**Boca Raton** - Researchers at Florida Atlantic University are looking for a few good men. Make that a lot of good men who will participate in a study on how we age.

The initiative came out of the university's desire to establish a meaningful research project and because South Florida has the highest proportion of older people than any other in the country, it seemed the right place to conduct a study on aging.

"There have been many longitudinal studies," Dr. Ruth Tappen said,

## Life of pioneer housewife a feature of Relay for Life fundraiser

**Deerfield Beach** - The life and times of the woman who built and occupied the city's historic Butler House will be portrayed by Historical Society Executive Director Carolyn Morris Saturday, Apr. 28, 4 to 8 p.m. under the banyan tree at the home where Alice Butler lived until her death in 1977 at the age of 92.

Morris admits she doesn't resemble the petite Alice Butler who came to Deerfield Beach in 1912 with her husband JD. But for this fundraiser which benefits the Relay for Life/American Cancer Society, she thought it would be "fun to have a character" from

the era and said this week, "so here I am sitting in a wig." For *The Pelican* photo session, Morris also wore a cloche hat and little, wire-rimmed spectacles similar to what Alice could have owned.

She will give a 15-minute presentation around 6 p.m. about the women who occupied Deerfield's historic home built in 1923. Alice grew up in Ohio and held a degree in music from a Quaker university. She met her future husband J.D. at Warm Springs, TX where he was taking the cure for a stomach ailment. She had accompanied her favorite uncle to the springs.

The couple came to Deerfield Beach

# Pompano Beach Chamber event offers some of the finer things in life

**Pompano Beach** - When Sicilian Oven co-owner Andrew Garavuso looks at the Fine Food and Wine event he sees new customers.

But when guests arrive at the event next month, they will be seeing and tasting some of the finest foods and wines offered in the community.

On May 22 from 6:30 to 9:30 p.m. at the Sheraton Suites, 555 NW 62 St., Fort Lauderdale, the Pompano

Beach Chamber of Commerce holds its annual Fine Food and Wine evening.

Just prior to the event, a special tasting will be held at 5:30 p.m. for VIPs who are willing to pay a bit more for first dibs at the gourmet feast.

Garavuso said the event represents an opportunity to connect with other businesses as well as finding new customers. "Word of mouth is always the best, but we've got to get them in here first,"

Garavuso added.

Along with Sicilian Oven, located in Lighthouse Point, between 25 and 30 South Florida restaurants will be part of the evening, offering selections from their menus for attendees to enjoy.

Café Maxx, Casa D'Angelo Ristorante, Hot Tomatoes, Crown Wine & Spirits, the Fin & Claw and Blue Martini are slated to be among them.

"This event is one of our largest fundraisers for

the chamber," said Ruthie Brooks, co-chair of the event. Lisa Spinelli, special events director, calls this evening the chamber's "signature event."

"We're definitely going to serve our Sicilian salad," said Garavuso, which is made with Romaine lettuce, Garbanzo beans, red onions, black olives, green olives, shaved Parmesan cheese, tomatoes, roasted candy walnuts and homemade balsamic vinaigrette. "It's to die for," he said, adding, that he might also bring out his mini meatballs but he hasn't solidified

the menu just yet.

In addition to the tastings, auctions items, including restaurant gift certificates, art, boating excursions, resort packages and more will raise the excitement level. A portion of the event proceeds will benefit the Dynamos of Pompano Beach, a non-profit organization started in 1976 that provides recreational opportunities for people with disabilities.

"It's an organization whose sole purpose is to provide

# Deerfield Beach studio finds niche producing large Styrofoam characters

**Deerfield Beach** - When John Belcher drives from his family home in Fort Lauderdale to his business in Deerfield Beach he sees his work all over the place.

So many large buildings sport his Styrofoam architectural features – moldings and decorations of various kinds.

But his most eye-catching creations are huge and colorful creatures and characters that are impossible to ignore.

For instance, football fans by the hundreds stop to have their picture taken with a 10-foot tall Styrofoam football player on display at Miami Dolphins football games.

Others pose for a photo with a 16-foot statue of Shaquille O’Neal next to a slightly shorter Dwayne Wade commissioned by the Miami Heat

and standing proudly at the games.

Those are only two of the unique creations built at Unique Rabbit Studios in Deerfield Beach, at 1250 S. Powerline Road. The figures begin as blocks of polystyrene foam which are shaped by artistic designers, skilled CAD technicians and state-of-the-art software.

Belcher, who has a background in construction, began the business in 2001 with a focus on architectural design features for buildings and then expanded it to include huge

statues and everything else it takes to transform one environment to another. He does it for buildings of all kinds. “We’ve done some really big churches,” Belcher said. “This [aspect of the business] takes us from the architectural market in South Florida into the world market.”

That larger market includes a number of theme restaurants. An Italian restaurant, for instance, relied on Unique Rabbit Studios to replicate the Roman Coliseum, one of the

# Gourmet on Wheels food truck event returns to Oakland Park

**Oakland Park** - Like a traveling mall food court, food truck events bring a multitude of different cuisines to a single location.

And tomorrow from 5 to 9 p.m. at the corner of Oakland Park Boulevard and Dixie Highway, Oakland Park will

host its latest food truck affair.

Gourmet on Wheels, presented by Oakland Park Main Street, offers fish tacos, burgers, Mediterranean style Kosher, short rib sandwiches, pulled pork, lobster rolls, Italian ice and more; all served across the counters of a few nomadic kitchens.

Siegi Constantine, Main Street's executive direc-

tor, said that because food trucks are a popular South Florida draw Main Street sees the event, now in its fourth installment, as one more way to expose people to downtown Oakland Park.

"We always look to showcase downtown. October was even better than September," said Constantine, referring to attendance levels.

Jack Garabediam, owner of Jefe's Original Fish Taco and Burger, which serves California style fish tacos, American burgers and fries, has been in the restaurant business for 35 years. And for the last two years he's been part of the food truck scene.

Garabediam says he started his food truck business because of what he saw as a lack of good Mexican food.

"This was the best way I could bring great Mexican food to people. 'I'm from East L.A. and I know what Mexican food is supposed to be like.'"

Asked why he drives all the way up to Oakland Park when his business is in Miami, Garabediam said, "There's no reason for them not to have some great Mexican food."

Partnering with Main Street is Debbie Blakely, owner of Big Dog Station, which is located at the corner where the event is being held.

Blakely said past events have brought a "really nice and diverse crowd" and some of them have come back through her doors in the days and weeks after the food trucks packed up and left. "Even people who live around the corner say, 'Wow, I didn't even know you were here,'" she said.

Along with the food trucks there will also be vendors and live entertainment. Parking is available along Oakland Park Boulevard near Dixie Highway, Northeast 12 Avenue, Northeast 11 Avenue and between Northeast 33 Street and Northeast 32 Street. For more, call 754-214-0041.

## Let's put on our Big Boy and Big Girl jeans on April 24

We at *The Pelican* support the recent position of the Broward County's stand to put a halt to sexual abuse and child abuse. Below is a statement from the county that asks all of us to take part in 'Denim Day' on April 24.

Broward County is encouraging all county residents to make a social statement with their fashion by wearing denim and denim ribbons on Denim Day, April 24, in observance of Sexual Assault Awareness and Child Abuse Prevention Month. Both the Broward County Commission and the Broward County School Board are issuing proclamations in support of this important cause.

"I hope that everyone will join the Broward County Commission in observance of Denim Day. Let us not forget that it was only fifteen years ago that an Italian high court issued this ruling against a rape victim who was wearing what they considered tight jeans. It was a travesty of justice for women worldwide and set off a nationwide movement that we support on this day by wearing denim," said Commissioner Barbara Sharief, who will present a proclamation designating April as Sexual Assault Awareness and Child Abuse Prevention Month and Tuesday, April 24, as Denim Day in Broward County.

### About Denim Day

Denim Day was started in Rome, Italy, in 1997. An 18-year-old girl was picked up by her 45-year-old driving instructor for her first lesson. He took her to an isolated road, pulled her out of the car and raped her, threatening her with death if she told anyone. She reported the assault and pressed charges.

The instructor was convicted of rape and sentenced to jail. He appealed and the Italian Supreme Court overturned the conviction and released the perpetrator. The chief judge argued that, "because the victim wore very, very tight jeans, she had to help him remove them, and by removing the jeans it was no longer rape but consensual sex."

Enraged by the verdict, women in the Italian Parliament launched an immediate protest by wearing jeans to work. The California Senate and Assembly were motivated to do the same, and a movement was born. Broward County has supported the Wear Denim campaign since 2009.

The theme for this year's Sexual Assault Awareness Month, "Broward Aware: Child Abuse Prevention – It Is Up to Us" and "It's Time...To Talk About It. Respect. Connect. Prevent Sexual Violence," underscores the fact that sexual assault and child abuse are intolerable crimes affecting everyone. Activities open to the public for the remainder of the monthlong observance include:

Time will tell when the state attorney is made aware of the circumstances surrounding the creation of this full page letter.

## Too much bad rhetoric about lights and turtles, says LBTS resident

To the Editor,

Here in the southeastern sector of Florida we are being bombarded with rhetoric about "saving the turtles." I can't believe the effort behind this campaign.

In the first place, the mature turtle lays her eggs just several feet from the water's edge, buries them deep and goes back to the sea. No lights affect this process. The site is always well recognized and impossible to miss.

The next morning the 'turtle patrol' comes by and carefully digs the eggs up for transportation to a hatching area. About an hour later the beach combing machinery comes by, scarifies the surface to collect the sea debris, makes intermittent piles and then comes back to dig holes in the sand and bury the debris.

If any nests were missed, they were plowed away and the eggs destroyed.

Now comes the rhetorical part: Turn off all lights within 400 feet of the beach and pull the curtains shut so no light is visible from the beach. The street lights are turned off even on some streets back from the beach. We have now created a perfect scenario for the muggers, rapists and thieves to commit their acts under the protection of darkness.

Now if that's not enough, some rocket scientist says turn off the lighthouse at the Hillsboro Inlet because the turtles are getting confused. Are you kidding? The light is 70 feet in the air, aimed high to the sea and turtles don't climb light-houses or even look up that far.

What about the sailors and pilots that depend on that light to keep human lives safe from the surrounding rocks and shoreline that juts out into the sea? How many turtles is one human life worth?

Let's get some common sense into this and ask, "When was the last time a turtle hatched on our beach?" And, who says they always hatch in the middle of the night?

but none from such a diverse area." Dr. Tappen and Dr. Joseph Ouslander broached their idea to a committee considering 40 other research suggestions and won the grant money being offered.

In the next 18 months, researchers will interview 800 people between the ages of 65 and 85 asking questions about medical and family history, eating habits, exercise, lifestyle, future plans, how they view themselves, how they function in their communities. In addition, evaluations of physical and mental prowess will be given. It may sound daunting, but it is accomplished in three, two-hour sessions.

According to Dr. Tappen there is no lack of volunteers, just a shortage of men willing to answer the questionnaires. "It is much easier to persuade women than men," she said. "But we need to understand the whole population."

Already cultural differences are emerging. In the group of 800 are people of European, Spanish, Caribbean Indian and African descent. Obvious cultural traditions exist.

The answers to the questions are being entered into a data bank. It may take years to draw conclusions but in the future Dr. Tarrant hopes to be able to re-contact her subjects to see how they are doing and if their answers today in some way predicted their futures.

The reward for those who participate is a \$10 Publix gift card per session and for those who agree, a free blood test. The blood samples are being held for possible future DNA testing. All participants are given complete confidentiality and identified only by a number. There are at least 10 sites in Broward, Palm Beach and Dade counties where volunteers for the South Florida Quality Aging Registry are interviewed.

Deerfield Beach resident Joan Gould is one of the researchers. On the job three months, she is finding it fascinating. To fulfill the ethnic

quotas, she is reaching out to men in ethnic groups. One of her resources has been the regional Kwianis Club organization that is putting her in touch with clubs in African-American and Latino neighborhoods. "You might say I am on a mission for men," Gould said.

In her short time on the job, Gould has talked with amazing people, some well into their 80s, who retain their zest for life and are planning for the future.

One of the test sections focuses on quality of life versus quantity, i.e. "Would you rather live longer not able

to get around much or have a shorter, but more active, healthier life?" It's a soul-searching question, one many people have avoided confronting she said. Another question probes values, i.e. what are some of the good things about growing older? People say such things as, "freedom to do what I want, leisure time, pleasant memories."

One thing Gould has discovered is money is not a primary factor in aging well. "I have talked to people who live in palatial homes in gated communities and have plenty of money, but who are becoming reclusive. And I am meeting people in over-55 communities like Kings Point

and Century Village who are busy all the time and having a lot of fun," she said.

Said Gould, "There has not been anyone I have met during these studies, whether 60, 70 or 90 years old, who didn't want another day to live in spite of their frailty, health or other issues. Of course, the folks that tend to participate in this type of study are generally more engaged, unselfish and willing to give of themselves to provide the insight we need to learn from these programs."



## Oakland Park moving forward with land buys

**Oakland Park** - City commissioners voted Wednesday to reprogram funds under an agreement with Broward County to purchased property in the city's downtown area. The vote at Wednesday's meeting was 4-1, Commissioner Suzanne Boisvenue dissenting.

A balance of \$10.2 million remains of an original \$13 million provided under the county's redevelopment capital program. The agreement expires June 21.

Squire Plaza, an assemblage of properties at 3400 NE 11 Ave., 3401 N. Dixie Highway, 1110 NE 34 Court and 3407 N. Dixie Hwy. for \$2.2 million and Schnell property at 1229 NE 37 St. for \$320,000.

The vote was unanimous on the Sikes property and 4-1, Boisvenue dissenting, on the other two. The commission will meet again at 6 p.m. on April 23, to consider purchases of additional properties.

Charities, the United Way, St. Jude's Catholic Church, the Moore Foundation, the Ahns Foundation, donations from John Knox Village and food donations from the Harvest Project. Currently there is just not enough money coming in to balance the Chapel's \$30,000 a month budget.

Fletcher has cut back on the transportation service that brings clients to the Chapel on

Blount Road and is operating with a skeleton staff: herself, a cook/driver and a part time nurse. Volunteers serve the food and manage the clothing bank. The county maintains the building.

Father Todd Hoover, assistance rector at St. Mary Magdalene Episcopal Church in Coral Springs, raised his concerns for the Chapel's future at the last city commission meeting. Afterward he pointed out that 80 to 100 people are fed at the Chapel every day where they also get

showers, clean clothing, a bin in which they keep their few possessions, nursing care, a mailing address, use of telephones and a place to sleep during the day. "They sleep in the pews and on the floor," Hoover said. "At night they walk the streets."

In these current economic times, the demographic at the shelter is changing. A few years ago, only five percent of the clients were female. Today that number is 20 percent. "We deal with the hardcore homeless," Father Hoover said. "We don't ask questions."

There are cases when people are sleep in their cars, come in for breakfast, shower and go to work. The Chapel is not set up to accommodate children, but families without a place to live are sneaking their kids in for very early-morning showers and then sending them off to school.

Fletcher approached the City of Pompano Beach for help last week and learned she had just missed the Mar. 30 deadline to apply for a Com-

munity Block Grant. Asst. City Manager Willie Hopkins said the Chapel meets the qualifications for block grant assistance, but will have to wait until next year.

He said he encouraged Fletcher to go to the county where the deadline has not yet passed.

Fletcher said her budget is strained by the high cost of vehicle insurance and maintaining the Chapel's two vans, the cost of food, the cost of propane used for the cooking grills, administrative expenses.

"There is not much respite for the homeless," Fletcher said. "But we keep them off the streets during the day, away from the beach and businesses."

The Chapel accepts donation of money, food and clothing at its 1698 Blount Road location until 4 p.m. five days a week. It is not open on Saturday or Sunday, but Father Hoover's church serves lunch the second Sunday of every month. This year, Easter fell on that day and more than

80 people came in for that traditional meal.

Father Hoover said one of the clients' biggest needs is shoes, men's shoes in particular. Because the homeless walk all night, shoes and socks are treasured items. Most homeless people sleep with their shoes on for fear of them being stolen, he said.

Mayor Lamar Fisher, when he heard about St. Laurence's financial difficulties said, "It saddened my heart that an organization that has helped hundreds of homeless folks has such financial constraints. There is truly a need for them; they fill a void in our community."

Fletcher said she will talk with county officials next week. She is hoping somewhere to find at least \$150,000 in grant money so the Chapel will be around to celebrate its 25th year anniversary.

## More roadwork underway on E. Hillsboro Boulevard

**Deerfield Beach** - Merchants and motorists, beleaguered by the ongoing E. Hillsboro Blvd. road project probably have one more week of frustration in store. The intersection of Federal Highway and Hillsboro and the roadway east to A1A is being repaved due to faulty work performed by the original asphalt contractor. There will be lane closures both day and night while the new layer of asphalt is put down and the road is striped.

Assistant City Manager Keven Klopp said the city purposely held the work off until the season ended. The inferior work was done in December and after an assessment, the city rejected it. "It was a substandard installation," Klopp said.

"The pavement was not as smooth as it should be." Klopp said the general contractor, Ricman Construction, was put on notice that work being done was substandard. Ricman has since hired another asphalt contractor, but there remains a dispute over payment which is in negotiation now, Klopp said.

Tragically, earlier this week, a worker was killed at the construction site when he walked behind a dump truck. Riccardo Corralles, 53, of Hialeah, was struck at 12:45 p.m. Tuesday in the 1600 block of Hillsboro Blvd. and declared dead shortly later at North Broward Medical Center. The boulevard, from Northeast 12 Avenue to A1A, was closed to traffic for several hours.

## Earth Day at City Campus promises education, giveaways and fun

**Deerfield Beach** - The city's new solar energy system

will be the star of the Arbor Day/Earth Day event Saturday, Apr. 28 at Central City Campus, 401 SW 4 Street.

The solar panel system, installed in December and activated Mar. 15, is clamped onto the roof of the environmental services building and produces 14.7 kilowatts of power a day, enough to have already saved about \$1,000 according to Chad Grecsek, assistant environmental services director.

The solar photovoltaic system was paid for with grant fund from the U.S. Department of Energy through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. Grecsek will be on hand to explain the system to attendees.

Also planned for the day are tree giveaways for residents, tours of the "green" environmental services building, rain barrel demonstrations and sales, paper shredding with the first box free for residents of Deerfield Beach and a demonstration of the automated side loader truck coming on line this summer to handle and record residential single stream recycling. Specialists from the Gumbo Limbo Preserve will talk about sea turtles and water conservation will be the topic for experts from the city's utility department.

The event runs from 8 a.m. until noon and is free.

## Union contract finalized; all employees face five percent wage cut

**Deerfield Beach** - A commission vote has forced the Professional Managers and Supervisors Association, or PMSA, to accept the same contract terms as the city's general employees: a five

percent wage decrease and a 10 percent contribution to insurance premiums.

The vote was taken at a hearing last week after the city and union representatives presented their arguments. The city and PMSA have been negotiating since July 2011 on a contract that affects 29 mid-management employees.

in March resulted in Deem agreeing with the city's wage and benefit position but the union did not budge on its position that the city gave raises to high-level employees while imposing the five percent cut. Human Resources Director Mike Milanowski said raises were given only to those employees promoted to new positions and given more responsibility.

Now that the PMSA contract is settled, the wages of all employees will be cut by five percent, and they will begin contributing to their health insurance premiums. The first checks to reflect the new wages will be issued May 11, Milanowski said.

Had the cut gone into effect at the beginning of the fiscal year Oct. 1, the city would have saved about \$750,000, he added.

## Blanche Ely girls flag football team wins Heritage Bowl, heads into playoffs

Ely's varsity team defeated Deerfield 6-0 and the junior varsity squad claimed victory 12-10. The Heritage Bowl is an unofficial game played between the two teams at the end of the season; Ely took home bragging rights to last year's game as well.

Ely's varsity ends its regular season 8 and 3 while Deerfield's varsity is 4 and 7. Both varsity teams are headed

to the district playoffs, which are scheduled to take place April 23 through 25. Ely's junior varsity team finished perfect at 6 and 0 while Deerfield ended their season at 6 and 1. Junior varsity teams don't have a playoff system.

Cameron Thomas, Deerfield's head coach, said his girls had a lot of dropped passes and failed to execute on key plays, something they will need to work on if they expect to advance.

Asked what he thought was his varsity players' biggest problem, Ely's head coach, Clenner Goodman, responded, "just consistency."

Goodman said defense and

offensive running were the two things his team most excels at. "They hardly give up any yards," said Goodman of the defense. He estimates that out of the season's 11 games, the varsity defense only allowed a total of 20 points. "They had a lot of shut outs," he said.

And as the team heads into the playoffs, Goodman says things on offense are looking better with the recent play of Jenette Hicks.

"She's basically been playing defense all year but she really showed her potential on offense," said Goodman of Hicks, who scored the winning touchdown for Ely during their last game.

## Pompano Pier Restaurant, 'boutique hotel' with 'Old Florida' themes part of East CRA plans

**Pompano Beach** – City commissioners, meeting as the board of the city's Community Redevelopment Agency, or CRA, will move ahead to prepare a development agreement with Pompano Pier Associates, LLC.

Tim Hernandez of New Urban Communities, a partner with Richard Caster in Pompano Pier Associates, presented their conceptual proposal Tuesday for a Pompano Beach Fishing Village on an eight-acre parcel along Pompano Beach Boulevard.

He said their vision is a pedestrian-friendly area, which showcases the natural assets of the beach area with multiple nodes of activity.

They will look to old

Florida-themed architecture.

For inspiration they visited CityPlace in West Palm Beach and at Key West.

"We will design with the historical context of Pompano Beach, including the fishing fleet and lighthouse," Hernandez said.

Plans include a restaurant with covered dining, a ceremonial green for weddings and memorial ceremonies and one and two-story retail buildings.

"We're looking to make this a destination, so it's crucial to get good operators," Hernandez said. They're hoping to include a small boutique, hotel with 120 rooms or so, similar to the Seagate Hotel in Delray Beach.

The developers will work to preserve view corridors for existing buildings. "Everyone who had a view of the water

will still have a view," Hernandez said.

They hope to be under construction by the end of 2013 or early 2014.

Resident Keith Mizell urged the board to move forward and OK the plans. "This is low density. It fits the site and the neighborhood," he said.

Board member Barry Dockswell questioned how the board could determine if they were getting a good financial deal. He suggested a third party assessment of the deal. No other board member agreed.

Dockswell also said the board hasn't focused enough on the library. He said a committed funding plan was needed. He said he believes the library should be on the west side of A1A not in the pier parking lot.

A development agreement will come before the city commission for approval in about 60 days.

### Pet grooming salon owner sees growth and opportunity in her industry



Sisters Princess and Martini, are always on hand with their owner, Maria Ledbetter, of Pup'e Cutz in Pompano Beach to welcome fellow canines for a day of beauty, health and puppy play.

**C**lip. Clip. Snip. Snip. A little here. A little there. The scissors click in Maria Ledbetter's hands as she sculpts a shaggy mane, and another client trots out the door looking well groomed,

neat and spiffy, and sporting a colorful bandana.

It's another day at PUP'e CUTZ, a pet grooming salon at 124 S. Federal Highway, in Pompano Beach, near Atlantic Boulevard.

Ledbetter, a licensed pet

groomer, is in her fifth year as the owner and operator of the salon. A self-described spiritual woman, Ledbetter talks passionately about the feelings of the animals she grooms. "Every living thing has feelings," she says. "And they feel

what you're feeling."

She takes pride in what she calls a holistic approach to her service and in grooming pets whose owners say other groomers won't take. That's why some of them call her the "dog whisperer."

At PUP'e CUTZ the animals aren't caged as they wait their turn to be bathed and groomed. Ledbetter tries to create a homelike atmosphere. She often plays dance music on the radio and engages pets in a dance routine. "I don't see the pets as possessions of their owners, but as members of their families," she says.

Ledbetter began the business in her fifties, after decades of varied work and travel. As she tells it, her courageous father brought the family from Columbia to the United States -- to Illinois -- to give his children a better education and the prospects of a better future. She went on to manage officers' clubs at U.S. military bases in Europe and Panama, own and manage a restaurant in Alabama, operate a 1700 acre farm in Honduras, where she did development work with the World Council of Churches. Along the way she also worked in catering and construction.

She took a new direction when a friend suggested that she think about the pet grooming business. After immersing herself in research, she was confident that there was a need for pet groomers.

Since opening her doors, she has built a family of clients including cats and ferrets who need their nails clipped, and dogs of all shapes and sizes, from Shih tzus and Yorkies to dalmations and poodles. She

has learned that the little ones can be the most difficult to groom. "Shih tzus -- because of their personality -- want to have it their own way," she says. "And Yorkies let their curiosity get them in trouble, and they're fast."

Besides grooming pets, she "baby sits" for some of them, providing doggy day care. She also provides pick-up service for elderly clients and those who can't travel.

When she launched her salon about five years ago, pet grooming was a multi-billion dollar industry in the United States, she says, and it has grown dramatically since then.

Increasing opportunity in the field fuels a professional dream. She recently was given a trademark for PUP'e CUTZ and thinks about expanding the business, opening other salons that would operate her way. This would give others an opportunity to manage their own business and be their own boss, she says. Energetic and ebullient, Maria Ledbetter bubbles with enthusiasm when she talks about her business and the pets that trot through her door. She is equally enthusiastic about her community.

Right now, she is content in Pompano Beach. She enjoys the "small town feel" of the community and the camaraderie provided by the Chamber of Commerce. "Other merchants are very helpful," she says. "It's like a family here. It's just an amazing community."



We all know that it has been tough to get out fishing due to the weather, so when it breaks just a little you've got to take your shot. I fished on a boat named John B, owned by John Bassett and his son John “Junebug” Bassett.




