One of the things that I've noticed over the years is that it's real easy to forget to pay attention to what the mouse is doing.

Fellsmere council approves 'rollback' property tax rate for upcoming year

FELLSMERE — The Fellsmere City Council has approved a tentative budget and property tax rate and will accept public comment on the matters during meetings held on Sept. 4 and Sept. 18 at 6 p.m.

While other Indian River County municipalities have approved tentative property tax rates higher than previous years,

Fellsmere is proposing a lower rate.

The current property tax rate is 5.6190, or approximately \$5.62 per \$1,000 of taxable value. The new proposed rate is 5.5309, or \$5.53 per \$1,000 and is considered a "rollback" rate, or a rate designed to capture the same level of revenue as the year previous, said Jason Nunemaker, city manager.

While the rate may be lower, that does not necessarily mean the property tax bill will lower in the new year because the

property values have increased slightly, nearly 4 percent.

With the tentatively approved property tax rate, a residential home valued at \$75,000 after any exemptions would see a city tax bill of \$414.82.

Mr. Nunemaker said with the combination of the rollback rate, increased property values and new construction, Fellsmere

School board wants to adopt lower tax rate, budget

INDIAN RIVER COUNTY — Indian River County School Board members gave initial approval to a tentative budget and property tax rate for the 2014-15 fiscal year, both numbers lower than the cur-

rent year.

The tentatively approved property tax rate is 7.995, or about \$7.99 per \$1,000 of assessed taxable value on property. The current rate is 8.116 or \$8.12 per \$1,000 of value.

The budget has been cut somewhat for the upcoming year, from \$275.4 million

down to \$269.9 million, said Carter Morrison, assistant superintendent of finance and operations.

Comments from the first public hearing on the tentative budget and millage rate on July 31 were not available at press time.

Parents reminded to immunize children for the new school year

TREASURE COAST — March of Dimes, the leading organization for mom and baby health, urges parents to immunize their children against infectious diseases before the beginning of the 2014-15 school year. Influenza, pertussis (whooping cough), and measles are just a few of the serious vaccine-preventable diseases that still affect children and adults in the United States today.

“Immunizations are as important today as they were in the age of polio in

the 1950s, when the March of Dimes funded the pioneering work that resulted in the vaccine that still is used today against this deadly disease,” said Dr. Karen Harris, chairwoman of the Program Services Committee for the March of Dimes Florida Chapter. “Back-to-school season is the time of the year when we especially encourage kids to get their shots to protect their health.”

Even small groups of unimmunized people can quickly spread disease, Dr. Harris says. In the U.S., both measles and whooping cough are at epidemic rates.

According to the Florida Department

of Health, the most recent school year (2013 – 14) immunization status reports for all 67 Florida counties indicate rates of:

- Kindergarten: 93.2 percent (State and National goal is 95 percent)
- Seventh grade: 96.6 percent (State goal is 95 percent; National goal is 90 percent)
- Two-year-old children (2013): 86.72 percent (State and National goal is 90 percent)

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention says diseases can spread when infected people cough, sneeze, or

even talk. Children may spread the flu virus for up to three days before they show any symptoms and for longer than a week after getting sick, putting their classmates at risk of becoming sick, too.

The CDC, the March of Dimes, and the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists all recommend that, in addition to children, all pregnant women and those planning to become pregnant should get an annual flu shot in the fall. The normal biological changes of pregnancy put pregnant women at

will see about \$11,000 more in revenue in the fiscal 2015 year.

Although the incoming funds are not expected to increase dramatically and the tax burden has not been increased on the community, the city is still prepared to provide enhanced services and infrastructure improvements.

Two ways Mr. Nunemaker proposes enhancing services is through the new hire of a full time police officer and the part-time hire of a public works employee to both mow city property and stay on top of stormwater projects within the city.

The police officer position is depend-

ent on receiving a Department of Justice grant whereby the Department of Justice would pay 75 percent of the officer's salary for the first three years and the city pays the remaining 25 percent.

One of the grant stipulations is that the city must promise to hire the officer for a full fourth year, but Mr. Nunemaker was clear that the position would be one the city would retain permanently.

Mr. Nunemaker also proposed a 3 percent salary increase for all employees, a new police vehicle, funds for furniture for the police department and a new lawn mower.

Customer service is gadget store's No. 1 priority

SEBASTIAN — For more than 20 years, the Sebastian Radio Shack Dealer has provided its customers with personalized service and doesn't show any signs of stopping.

The small store located in the Roseland Plaza at the corner of U.S. Highway 1 and Roseland Road has a little bit of everything for just about anyone.

For the do-it-yourself-er, the store carries a variety of small electrical parts that can be used to build virtually anything, from robots to batteries; for the gadget guys and gals, there are a variety of electrical devices that can enhance a home, from intercom systems to long range WiFi receivers; for the budget-conscious shopper, tall antennas to pick up free television channels are available in store, as are several types of non-contract phone and service provider information.

Play and learn

Vero Beach couple spearheads educational online game, raising funds for first release

INDIAN RIVER COUNTY — For children, playing games is as natural as breathing. One video gaming company started by Vero Beach natives is hoping to capitalize on that love of play and create a virtual world where students can play and learn simultaneously.

Lindsey Tropf is the CEO and founder of Immersed Games, an educational gaming startup based in Gainesville. She and her team have a long-term goal of creating a social online learning game set in a virtual world.

Currently the company is hosting an online fundraising campaign through Kickstarter to help cover the cost of programming and building the game to make it available to the general public.

In today's world, many children spend countless hours playing in imaginary worlds using computers or other electronic devices and truly become invested in the game, the game story and even other characters within the game, Ms. Tropf said.

While she was a student at Sebastian River High School, Ms. Tropf was introduced to her first massive multiplayer online role playing game, Achaea, and she quickly became wrapped up in the game world.

"I was obsessed," Ms. Tropf said. "Maybe one-third of my time was spent playing that game. Eventually I realized that everything I knew about the game, the world, the characters, the creatures, none of that mattered outside the game world. I thought it



would be awesome to use something like that, an immersive world that linked with real learning" she said.

There are educational video games in the market, but the games tend to be short and contain perhaps a few hours of content before the game has been "won" or completed. Immersed Games has created a game concept, Tyto Online, where there is an entire world with an enormous backstory so there is constantly new things for players to explore.

Tyto Online's storyline would include challenges players would have to accept and meet in order to advance their character in the virtual

world, and those challenges, or quests, would be the platform for learning opportunities.

As the small company is just now raising the funds to produce the game, the game would be rolled out in phases, or modules, with the first module focused on ecology, Ms. Tropf said.

Eventually, as funding increases, further modules would be able to have other focus areas, including arts, history, entrepreneurship and financial literacy, a press release said.

Ms. Tropf, a doctoral candidate in school psychology at the University of



While the future tax rate may be lower than the current rate, it isn't quite as low as a rollback rate, or a rate set to capture the same amount of revenue as the year previous.

The tentatively approved rate, combined with a more than 4 percent increase in property values in Indian River County could mean some homeowners will see an increase in their tax bills, Mr. Morrison said.

To demonstrate a sample tax bill based on the proposed rate, Mr. Morrison gave an example of a property owner with a home valued, after exemptions, at \$175,000.

In 2013, the homeowner would have expected a tax bill of \$1,420.30. If there was no increase in value to the property, in 2014-15 the homeowner could expect to pay \$1,399.13,

or a 1.49 percent decrease.

However, the county property appraiser has certified a 4.65 increase in property values and the same house would be valued in the 2014-15 year at \$184,300, which would put the 2014-15 tax bill at \$1,473.48, representing a 3.74 percent increase, Mr. Morrison said.

In the proposed budget, there was a decrease in the capital projects line item of about \$13.4 million, but increases in the general operating budget and other line items canceled out the large decrease. Still, the proposed budget is less than the current year by about \$5.4 million, he said.

The second public hearing on the budget and the property tax rate will be Sept. 9 at 5:01 p.m. in the school board meeting room.

increased risk of the harmful effects of flu. Recent research suggests that the flu vaccine may also lower a woman's risk of having a stillbirth or miscarriage. "The flu vaccine helps protect your body from infection, and this protection is in turn passed on to your baby during pregnancy," adds Dr. Harris, explaining that immunization during pregnancy helps keep the newborn safe during the first few months of life until he or she is ready for the first set of vaccinations.

Parents, grandparents, caregivers, and anyone in close contact with an infant should get an adult pertussis vaccine to help protect themselves and to help stop the spread of the disease to the newborns in their lives. Newborns are most at-risk for this highly contagious and often serious disease because they don't begin receiving their own vaccinations until they are two months old and may not be protected until they have received

at least three doses of an infant pertussis vaccine. This year, the March of Dimes continues their work on the Sounds of Pertussis® Campaign, a national education campaign started in 2009 to help raise awareness about the potential dangers of pertussis and the importance of adult vaccination.

March of Dimes also supports the "Word of Mom: Celebrating Generations of Healthy Advice" campaign, which empowers moms to make the best health decisions for themselves and their families by making sure their families' immunizations are up to date.

March of Dimes continues to fund vaccine research and to work with international coalitions seeking to improve immunization rates and eliminate preventable diseases that threaten babies and children.

Florida, is also working on a dissertation in educational games.

"At first I thought I just wanted to study educational games, but as a gamer, I realized there wasn't anyone doing what I thought I could do," Ms. Trof said.

Tyto Online's storyline starts in the future, in the 2200s, when Earth leaders and scientists realize the world is becoming unable to sustain life. A mass evacuation was ordered and some people were put in a sleeping state. In the game, the player is one of those sleepers who has been awakened and is tasked with learning, exploring and with an overall mission to one day restore Earth, a press release said.

Many times objects on computer screens, like buttons icons and such, will respond not just when clicked, but often when the mouse just passes over. These "mouse-overs" can be the source of many a hint to help you on your way.

You may have noticed while browsing the Internet that some things on websites change as you move your mouse around. Sometimes a button will change color or a pictures title will

appear if the mouse is held over it for long enough. If your mouse passes over a link, the pointer may change from an arrow to a pointing finger. In Windows programs, buttons, menus and controls often brighten as your mouse passes over them to give you a visual clue you are now pointing at a clickable control. There, again, the secret is to pass your mouse slowly over an object and pay attention in order to see anything.

The reason I keep harping on that is sometimes I work with someone who just can't resist the urge to wiggle that mouse. Every time something's loading or we're trying to work out

how to do something, he's moving the mouse all over the screen. Many times we'll be trying to work out a procedure but with that mouse flying all over, we can't get any thinking done! But, as soon as the mouse stops, and we start pointing at things and pausing and start paying attention to our mouse, we start to make progress.

So, what are some of the clues to watch for when your pointer passes over something? Well, one of the things that you'll likely see is your pointer will turn into a double-sided arrow. If you will notice, when the very tip of your pointer moves over the very edge of certain objects (like the edge of a window), the pointer will sometimes turn into a double sided arrow. This is your computer's way of telling you that you can stretch whatever it is that you are currently pointing at. All you have to do is click and hold while it's a double arrow and you should be able to change the size that object just by dragging the mouse.

In many Microsoft programs like Internet Explorer, XL and Word, holding your mouse over buttons and

controls will often yield a small pop-up window with a short, two or three-word description of the control. The thing is, many times this little pop-up doesn't appear for a second or so, so if you're all over the place with the mouse, you just may miss it.

In things like word processors or email programs, you may notice the mouse turns into this oversized capital "I."

This pointer is called the "I Beam," and its shape is specifically designed to get right between the letters. When your pointer turns into an I Beam, that's your clue that the part of the screen you're pointing at is for typing.

Yeah, there sure is a lot on a computer that can serve to distract you. One of the best ways to stay on track is to pay attention to what your mouse is pointing at, take it easy and follow your mouse. Many times the answers that you are looking for are right under your pointer.

Small diner boasts great food, faithful patrons

SEBASTIAN — For good conversation, friendly service and excellent chow, look no further than JD's Grill and Coney Island in Sebastian.

The little restaurant is tucked into the inside corner of Roseland Plaza on U.S. 1, but the staff is anything but shy.

Even during the busiest hours of the day the wait staff has a friendly "hello" for every single customer who walks through the day, for regular and newbies, although for regulars it is usually accompanied by "Do you want your usual?"

The banter between the staff, customers and kitchen staff is amusing and entertaining during a quick breakfast or lunch break.

All you have to do is come in, find a seat and you are assured of finding

something good to eat.

The menu is very reasonably priced, with the most expensive item on the menu checking in at just under \$9 is the Motor City omelet, made with four extra-large eggs, ham, bacon, sausage, corn beef, green peppers, onions, tomatoes and Swiss and American cheeses.

For breakfast, the restaurant has the traditional combinations of eggs, bacon, ham, cheeses, pancakes and waffles, but for something a little different the large wrap, which can be made with a white, wheat or spinach tortilla is filled with scrambled eggs with chorizo, cheddar cheese, tomatoes, green peppers and onions and salsa and sour cream.

The delicious and generously-filled wrap is served straight from the stove with the cheese melted and heat rising off the plate, along with a side, either

hash browns or home fries.

For a midday meal, there are just as many options, from salads, to soups to sandwiches, and of course, hot dogs.

The Coney Dog is a hot dog smothered in chili and drizzled with onions and mustard, such an excellent combi-

nation for a tasty lunchtime treat that takes the mind back to fun times at state fairs and amusement parks.

A trip to north Florida and the beautiful Gerber Daisy

A couple weeks ago my wife and I had an opportunity to travel through several areas of our beautiful state. We decided to leave town for a couple of days and we headed to some uncharted areas of north Florida. We visited a very quaint town called Keystone Heights. Keystone Heights is located about 35 minutes north of Gainesville and is almost due west of St. Augustine. It's amazing how only a 4-hour drive can change the entire landscape.

I think the first thing I noticed as we drove north was that we saw fewer palm trees and more pine and oak. This is especially true in the small rural communities that dot the landscape. Along many of the rural roads that we had to travel to get to our destination, wildflowers were in full bloom and added a breathtaking touch of color to the landscape. We saw plenty of wild petunia, periwinkle and aster. In many of the landscapes of people's homes we

observed dogwood trees and plenty of oaks. The many small ponds and creeks were brimming with water lilies and lotus lilies.

Our trip home was just as exciting as we decided to stop at Silver Springs in Ocala. This was indeed a pleasurable experience. Silver Springs is now a State Park. Along with the glass bottom boats that it is most famous for, the park boasts lots of activities such as kayaking and more. The final leg of our journey took us through the picturesque Ocala National Forest. This is one of the most scenic drives in the state with native trees and wildflowers in full bloom along most of the drive.

Did I mention the road has hills? Yes real hills, something we don't see much of in our area.

To get the Ocala National Forest take I-95 north into Brevard County and take highway 40 west towards Ocala. It will indeed be a pleasurable experience!

Getting back to home, I am going to talk about Gerber daisies. Unlike many of the other varieties of daisies, Gerber daisies can provide a summer full of color. They do in a sunny location but will require daily watering during the hotter summer months to prevent wilting. Gerber daisies also do very well in containers on a patio or sunny porch. Although they are perennials in Florida, they can be grown as annuals in other parts of the country and can even be grown indoors in a sunny window.

When you are shopping for your colorful treasures, don't pick the flowers with the most open blooms but

rather choose the ones that have plenty of buds. This will ensure a longer bloom cycle. It is a good idea to pinch the spent flowers off the plant as this will help to promote new blooms. The flowers of the Gerber daisy are great for making cuttings for your favorite flower vase.

You should plant your colorful gems in well-drained soil in a sunny location. As noted earlier, you will need to water your plants daily and sometimes twice a day during the hot summer months. You should also feed your plants once a week with a good all-purpose water-soluble fertilizer.

With a little care and TLC, this is one plant that will give you many weeks of rewarding color.

more lush tropical plants and canopies, carefully tended and encouraged to flourish.

Miriam Charles, director and garden-er of Heathcote, said the summertime garden is constantly in bloom.



Stuart offers luxurious golfing excursion close to home

By now most of us need a break from our summer. The kids are home all day, the boss has doled out too much work because he or she is on vacation, and everything else just seems to be piling up.

Luckily, you don't need to go far to get away from the craziness. In fact, you can roll the family car out of the driveway, take a short drive and enjoy a weekend away from it all.

The Hutchinson Island Marriott Beach Resort & Marina in Stuart offers everything you need to recharge your batteries without making a long trip to do so.

Located on 200 acres between the Atlantic Ocean and the Indian River Lagoon, the resort offers 274 deluxe accommodations, unspoiled beaches, a marina, fine dining and bars, a BBQ and picnic area, babysitting services, fitness center, tennis courts, three swimming pools, wave runner and kayak rentals, bicycle rentals, and much more. There are even plenty of activities designed just for the kids so that you can truly "get away".

The Ocean Club Course, designed by Charles Ankrom and renovated by Dick Gray, is the jewel of the resort. This 18-hole track recently underwent renovations to all of its greens. Just over two years ago the greens complexes on the front-nine were completely torn -up and rebuilt. This past winter, it was the back-nine's turn. The

results are phenomenal and the course's friendly staff is rightfully proud.

I was invited out last weekend to play the course and compare it to other resorts in the area. The work on the greens may have interrupted the busy winter season for the resort's members and guests, but it was well worth it. The new greens are as close to perfect as I've seen in some time. They hold and track well. In fact, my putts rolled as if on a pool table with just enough undulations to make things interesting.

Of course the greens are young and will take a little while to get into perfect condition. The staff is being careful not to cut them too short and risk stressing the young grass or allowing it to burn in the heat.

There are three sets of tees on this par-61 track that measures just over 4,000 yards from the tips. The front nine plays out to the Indian River Lagoon, while the back-nine takes you out toward the Atlantic Ocean.

At The Ocean Club, 12 par-3s await you. There are five par-4s and the

finishing hole is a wonderful 485-yard par-5. While the shortest par-3 plays just 120 yards from the back, there are two long par-3s as well to test your game. Four of the par-4s play to the cardinal points on the compass. This means that where the wind may help you on one hole, the next it could be in your face, or coming from your right or left. This course has enough teeth to test better players, yet remains fun for the true recreational golfer.

If you play from the correct set of tees, Ocean Club will surely test your game. If you can play to your handicap around this track, you have had a solid round. There is a great variety of holes here. I hit eight different clubs off the tee on the par-3s. Looking back at my round, I hit nearly every club in my bag, except for my short wedges, at least once from the tee.

Every hole is well framed and laid out. The villas surrounding the course do not come into play, but do make for tricky wind patterns that add to the difficulty of the course. Being so close to the ocean and river, means that there is nearly always a breeze, and it can change from hour to hour.

The 18th hole here is a great hole. It's not often that we recreational golfers get a chance to reach the green on a par-5 in two. Playing under 500 yards long, a solid tee shot will leave most of us with a fairway wood or hybrid second shot to the green. Of

course, it's not an easy shot with water lurking in front and left of the green. Fortunately, the green is very deep and receptive to long shots. Then there is always the way I played it. Hit a poor tee shot to the left and have to layup and then hit a wedge into the green.
