

2012 West Indies Regatta May 4-7

The fourth annual West Indies Regatta takes place in Saint Barth, May 4-7, with a line-up of charming traditional wooden sailboats and a fabulous classic schooner, Scaramouche, all of which represent the golden age of sailing in the Caribbean. Considered more of a wooden boat festival than a true competitive regatta, the goal of the event is to promote and encourage traditional boat building in the Caribbean islands.

Organized by Alexis Andrews, a nautical photographer based in Antigua, and a huge proponent of safeguarding these classic sailboats. the fourth edition of the West Indies Regatta feasloops schooners fro Antigua, Carriacou. All local sailors are invited to sail during the event, and the schooner Scaramouche is open to the public for a welcome party on the evening of May 4. 

INTERNET: AN ADDITIONAL FIBER-OPTIC CABLE BETWEEN GUSTAVIA AND LORIENT

The Collectivity hopes to install its own fiber-optic cable between the subscriber connection nodes (SCN) that run from Gustavia to Lorient, in addition to the cable already installed by the telecommunications company, Orange. The Collectivity's goal is to rent its own cable to other Internet providers on the island. such as Dauphin Telecom and Mediasery. This project, once completed, would allow the windward side of the island. which depends on the SCN in Lorient, to have better Internet service via the steady, high-speed connection assured by fiber-optic technology. Cable troughs have already been installed between Gustavia and Lorient to house the fiberoptic cable, but the Collectivity has yet to issue the RFP for bids on the completion of the project.

Melanie Smith New President Of SBIPOA



On Thursday, April 12, Melanie Smith became the new president of the Saint Barth International Property Owners Association when the new board was announced during a meeting at Le Massai restaurant in Lorient. The April meeting was the final one for 2012. The guest speaker was Sophie Olivaud, director of the island's technical services department, which covers everything from roads to water treatment. She addressed many of the current issues facing the island, and admitted that the solutions are not always simple, especially in confronting increased population growth and the pressure that puts on the island's resources. The association's meetings in 2013 season will be held on January 17, February 21, March 21, and April 4. All international residents and long-term renters are welcome to become members.




adults, including artists Antoine Heckly and Rose Marie Bénédet, plus Alexandra Härmälä, who did five of the drawings.
