The Environmental Division at Naval Air Station Key West is charged with ensuring the air station's ability to meet its mission requirements of supporting operational and readiness requirements of the Department of Defense and other agencies in an environmentally responsible manner.

In other words, besides being the right thing to do, good envi-

ronmental stewardship keeps the air station in compliance, which in turn, keeps the base here to do its mission - train warfighters.

With NAS Key West located smack in the middle of such an environmentally sensitive area as the Florida Keys, the Environmental Division closely monitors air station activities so that there is not only minimal impact to the environment, but the overall environmental footprint is reduced. 

## Every day is Earth Day at NAS Key West

This special issue of the Southernmost Flyer commemorates the annual observance of Earth Day and highlights our environmental efforts.

In many respects, every day is "Earth Day" here at NAS Key West since every aspect of our mission here is guided with the environment in mind. Up

until the 1960s, little attention was paid to the environment and the damage being caused by industry and the federal government. Civic and government action

changes to harmful practices grew and on January 1, 1970, the first major law directed at federal agencies established a national environmental policy with goals for the protection, maintenance, and enhancement of the environment. That law is the National Environmental Policy Act, or "NEPA" as it is often called. Whatever we do here, the

NEPA process is closely followed.

What is the NEPA process? Essentially, NEPA is a formal process of evaluating the environmental effects of any planned project, and if required, evaluate alternatives for that project. If the NEPA process is triggered during a preliminary environmental investigation, it could result in one of three levels of NEPA documentation: a Categorical Exclusion, an Environmental Assessment (EA), or if potential significant impacts are possible, an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS). The process includes cooperation and involvement of federal, state, and local governments, and other concerned public and private organizations and citizens.

Over the past decade, NEPA processes have locally guided a harbor dredging project, the ongoing airfield clearance and drainage project, the introduction of the F/A-18 E/F aircraft for transient operations, and the clean up and restoration of federal lands.

NAS Key West has a history of being environmental stew-

ards as illustrated by:

- 18 years of no hazardous waste disposal violations
- Both marinas designated "Clean Marinas,"
- Being an unsolicited nominee by Florida Fish & Wildlife for their regional award
- Having a proactive recycling program
- Partnerships with the Nature Conservatory and other similar organizations
- Volunteerism in local community clean up and restoration efforts.

None of it would be possible if it weren't for the men and women of NAS Key West - both civilian and military, that go above and beyond the environmental standards each and every day. It is part of our culture!

Take the extra effort this week to learn a little more about NAS Key West's environmental policy and the Environmental Management System. Become even more active and aware in protecting the environment through everyday practices such as recycling, energy conservation, or parking your car and taking the bus to work. You can make a difference!

## April is National Alcohol Awareness Month

The alcohol content of standard drinks of beer, dinner wine or distilled spirits (either straight or in a mixed drink) are equivalent - about six-tenths of an ounce each. They're all the same to a Breathalyzer. So it's not which you choose to drink but how much you drink that's important.

### Alcohol Equivalence

The alcohol content of a standard drink of beer, dinner wine, or distilled spirits (either straight or in a mixed drink) are equivalent. To a breathalyzer, they are all the same.

The health benefits associated with drinking in moderation are also similar for beer,

wine and spirits. The primary factor associated with health and longevity appears to be the alcohol itself.

Knowing about equivalence can help you drink in moderation. For example, you won't be fooled by the misleading term "hard liquor," which implies that drinking distilled spirits leads more quickly to intoxication than other alcohol beverages.

### Tips for Drinking in Moderation

Know your limit. If you are not sure, experiment at home with your spouse or some other responsible individual. Explain what you are attempt-

ing to learn. Most people find that they can consume one drink per hour without any ill effects.

Eat food while you drink. Food, especially high-protein food such as meat, cheese and peanuts, will help slow the absorption of alcohol into your body.

Sip your drink. If you gulp a drink, you lose the pleasure of savoring its flavors and aromas.

# Bright idea becomes air station's first solar-powered project

Key West's sunset celebrations leave behind a day full of tourist memories. Eight miles north on Boca Chica Key, red lights along the airfield's perimeter blink on and off in the growing darkness like an approving audience at a rock concert. What makes this night-time performance special? Instead of memories and tan lines, the lights blink on and off courtesy of electricity produced and stored from a day in the sun.

"NAS Key West has a line of solar-powered, flashing red lights around primary

surface boundaries to warn pilots of obstructions near the runways," said NAS Key West Airfield Manager Drew Lasseter. "There are tall, chain link fences and the flashing red lights provide a visual reminder that they're there."

The perimeter airfield obstruction light array became the first completed solar project at NAS Key West. The air station's renewable energy initiative is a small part of an overall base-wide effort to improve energy efficiency and reduce growing utility costs in the face of rising electricity rates.

Pedro Falcon Electrical Contractor of Big Pine Key, Fla., installed the original array of

34 solar powered lights more than four years ago. Following Hurricane Wilma, the contractor returned and repaired the array back to working order.

According to Bob Allsbrook, who helped installed the original lights and repaired storm damage, the light array consists of a solar panel that keeps a 12-volt car battery fully charged, and a flashing red light that draws power from the battery during the night. During daylight hours, the battery is recharged and an internal electrical switch prevents the battery

from becoming overcharged.

While the airfield perimeter obstruction light system is the air station's first renewable energy project incorporating solar power, Key West's famous weather promises more solar projects here to come. Naval Facilities Engineering Command Southeast recently announced execution of \$248 million in projects as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). A solar-integrated roof project to be installed here is one of the projects funded.

"NAS Key West was a top candidate for the project because of our high utility costs and high number of sunshine days," said Naval Facilities Engineering Command Southeast Detachment Key West Public Works Officer Lt. Cmdr. Ana Franco.

While NAS Key West's solar-powered airfield obstruction light project may seem small by other Navy renewable energy projects, it's another step toward a greener planet while providing energy savings and cost savings for the Navy.

### Maintenance Tip

#### Light bulbs and fixtures

The BBC homes at Key West contain several types of bulbs. The rule of thumb to follow is that if the bulb can be screwed into the fixture, the resident is responsible for replacing them. If it is a fluorescent bulb the maintenance staff will replace and dispose of them. Bulbs for personal lighting fixtures are not replaced by the maintenance staff. If the screw-in bulb breaks off in the light socket please place a trouble call and we will help to remove the bulb base. Common fixtures that the resident is responsible for are:

- Ceiling fan bulbs
- Range exhaust hood bulb
- Exterior security lights (flood lights)

And, everywhere possible, use compact fluorescent bulbs to save energy.

### Cooking with Chef Ellie

#### Salami Crisps with Sour Cream and Basil

24 (1/8- to 1/4-inch) slices Italian dry salami  
1/3 cup sour cream  
3 tablespoons thinly sliced fresh basil leaves

Preheat the oven to 325 degrees. Line 2 heavy large baking sheets with aluminum foil. Arrange the salami in a single layer over the baking sheets. Bake until the salami slices are amber brown watching closely to ensure they brown evenly, about 15 minutes. Transfer the salami crisps to a paper towel lined baking sheet to absorb the excess oil. Set aside to cool. Spoon a dollop of sour cream on top of each salami crisp. Sprinkle the basil over and serve.

Don't participate in "chugging" contests or other drinking games.

Accept a drink only when you really want one. If someone tries to force a drink on you, ask for a non-alcohol bev-

erage instead. If that doesn't work, "lose" your drink by setting it down somewhere and leaving it.

Skip a drink now and then. Having a non-alcoholic drink between alcoholic ones will help keep your blood alcohol content level down, as does spacing out your alcoholic drinks.

Keep active; don't just sit around and drink. If you stay active you tend to drink less and to be more aware of any effects alcohol may be having on you.

Beware of unfamiliar drinks. Some drinks, such as zombies and other fruit drinks, can be deceiving as the alcohol content is not detectable.

Therefore, it is difficult to space them properly.

Use alcohol carefully in connection with pharmaceuticals. Ask your physician or pharmacist about any precautions or prohibitions and follow any advice received.

Remember...

A glass of white or red wine, a bottle of beer, and a shot

of whiskey or other distilled spirits all contain equivalent amounts of alcohol and are they same to a Breathalyzer. A standard drink is:

A 12-ounce bottle or can of regular beer

A 5-ounce glass of wine

A one and 1/2 ounce of 80 proof distilled spirits (either straight or in a mixed drink)



# NAS contract will greatly reduce energy use by 2015

A \$8 million Department of the Navy contract at Naval Air Station Key West is expected to pay big dividends in the future by reducing energy use, carbon dioxide emissions and saving valuable manpower resources.

The contract awarded to NORESCO by Naval Facilities Engineering Command last September will help NAS Key West meet energy reduction goals specified by the federal government and the U.S. Navy.

"In January 2007, President George W. Bush signed Executive Order 13423 charging federal agencies to reduce energy use by three percent annually or by 30 percent by 2015," said NAS Key West Environmental Director Ed Barham. "The NORESCO contract will help us reduce our energy use by 18 percent from an established bench line which represents nine years of energy reduction goals."

According to NORESCO Senior Project Developer Lawrence Stoff, the work here will be done as an energy-savings performance contract (ESPC) and will be funded by guaranteed cost savings over 15 years. This self-funding contract arrangement eliminates the lengthy delay for capital appropriations funds to become available in the Navy's annual defense budget to pay for the energy infrastructure improvements.

"NAS Key West faces great challenges in meeting energy reduction goals because of the high summer temperatures and humidity," said Stoff. "Add to the fact the base already had some of the highest utility costs

in Navy Region Southeast. This project will help reduce energy consumption by the square foot and make important infrastructure improvements now that couldn't otherwise be done until money came available through typical budget processes."

According to Roy Dolley, NAS Key West's contracted resource efficiency manager, initial improvements include:

- Full-feature building automation systems that will replace older systems in five buildings and will be added in 12 buildings with no current central controls
- Specialized room occupancy sensors and thermostats in visitors quarters buildings that will significantly reduce the need for air conditioning when the buildings are unoccupied or indoor temperatures don't require the need for air conditioning
- Energy-efficient lighting upgrades in workspaces that will reduce energy use
- Upgrades to two existing chiller plants by adding new state-of-the-art high-efficiency chillers, new pumps, and variable speed drives.

"The one thing many Sailors here will see right away are contractors replacing light fixtures in workspaces that will turn the lights off automatically when no one is in the room," said Dolley. "People will notice the difference when they enter a room and the lights go on automatically. It takes a few seconds for them to burn at full brightness."

While the success of the contract will be measured in how much it saves NAS Key West in future utility bills, the benefits for a "greener" planet can't be ignored either.

"We estimate that the annual reduction from carbon dioxide emissions will be about 11,200,000 pounds of CO2 or the equivalent of 985 fewer cars on the street," said Stoff.

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# Programs aim to restore environment at contaminated sites

Nearly two centuries of Navy presence in the Florida Keys conjures up memories of great historic moments and accomplishments. But in retrospect, environmental practices and processes used today were non-existent.

For more than 20 years, the Department of Defense's Environmental Restoration Program (DERP) has guided the military services' response to potentially hazardous and toxic sites on active and former military installations prior to 1986. Here at NAS Key West, the Navy works toward a cleaner environment through the Installation Restoration (IR) and Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) programs.

The IR program is a process the air station uses to identify former contaminated sites through intensive sampling and evaluations and then

develops the most timely and cost effective cleanup process.

"Our IR program started in 1988 and we've done a good job in identifying all potentially contaminated sites," said NAS Key West Environmental Director Ed Barham. "In some areas around our property where the environmental threat is minimal, we've employed Land Use Control (LUC) restrictions which prohibit development or reuse. The cost benefit to the average taxpayer is enormous."

According to Robert Courtright, the air station's IR program manager, part of the success of NAS Key West's IR program is public participation in the process. Many sites where contamination occurred years ago were located through casual discussions with local residents, retired service members and civilian employees who remember where potentially harmful

spills or improper disposals occurred years ago.

"We recently visited a former Hawk Missile Site at Geiger Key with a retired service member who was stationed there during the 1960s," said Courtright. "From that single visit, we were able to identify additional environmental impacts that occurred there. With that information we were able to pursue a larger plan to analyze and clean up any contamination."

Another part of the community outreach program is the air station's Restoration Advisory Board (RAB). The advisory panel was created in December 1995 and includes local residents in its membership. The purpose of the RAB is to improve awareness and communication between the Navy and the community regarding local environmental issues.

"These meetings are held once a year and the next meet-

ing will be scheduled sometime in June," said Barham. "We'll announce the exact day, time and location next month and everyone is welcome to attend and participate."

NAS Key West monitors 12 sites that employ land use restrictions and are part of the IR program. The program ensures contamination levels are depleting and no further threats to the environment occur. Seven of the sites are on Boca Chica, two on Fleming Key and three on Truman Annex. Land use controls are in place at the locations, and the sites are reviewed every five years to determine if the selected course of action to remedy the situation continues to be appropriate for each site.

Former Navy property given to the city of Key West and Monroe County falls under a separate program for environmental clean up. The base realignment and closure (BRAC) program is responsible for addressing any con-

tamination that occurred on those sites.

The Navy has performed several cleanup actions in the city of Key West's Truman Annex waterfront area. Three areas where a former Defense Reutilization Marketing Office (DRMO) was located underwent extensive remedial cleanup in the last two years. Additionally, the Navy completed monitoring of groundwater conditions in the southwest corner of the former Navy Poinciana Plaza Housing complex on Duck Avenue in Key West.

"While the BRAC program is separate and distinct from the air station's IR program, it's another example of the Navy's concern for the environment," said Barham. "There may be further clean up actions in these areas depending on what is decided by the city. The key is making sure the property is returned to a safe and healthy level for what local governments want to use the property for."

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



## Lower Keys marsh rabbit calls NAS Key West home

Naval Air Station (NAS) Key West is home to a one-of-a-kind native rabbit that has free run of approximately 333 acres of U.S. Navy land.

Environmental Division is working with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS), Ecological Services Division, and Texas A&M University, Department of Wildlife and Fisheries Sciences, to preserve the Lower Keys marsh rabbit, which has been on the endangered species list since 1992.

A limited area of marsh wetland habitat for these small brown rabbits makes them more vulnerable to becoming extinct. George Kenny, NAS Key West natural resource

manager said it's important to protect the rabbits.

"The Navy is in charge of restoring and protecting this habitat," said Kenny. "I think it's something we need to do in conjunction with the mission of the base; I think it's definitely a possibility to do that."

Kenny said there is an airfield restoration project currently in the planning stages to convert mangrove wetlands into salt marsh wetlands, which will make more room for the marsh rabbit to call home.

"This project is a win-win situation," said Kenny.

NAS Key West Environmental Director Edward Barham said the continued survival of this unique

species of rabbit is due to the base's environmental policies and land management practices.

"NAS Key West is one of the largest land owners in the Florida Keys and, like at many military installations, much of our land is in its natural, undeveloped condition and habitat for these species," said Barham. "We have an obligation to protect these species and their habitats, while also meeting our military mission requirements. For example we have about 1/3 of the entire Lower Keys marsh rabbit population on our property and take very seriously the protection, enhancement and monitoring of the rabbits and their habitat."



## Managing stormwater and wastewater an NAS priority

### FROM NAS KEY WEST ENVIRONMENTAL DEPARTMENT

Naval Air Station Key West's Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) is an engineering and management strategy prepared specifically for NAS Key West to improve the quality of the storm water runoff and thereby improve the quality of the receiving waters.

The SWPPP has been written according to Navy Instructions, which requires that all Naval facilities comply with the requirements of the Clean Water Act of 1972. The Clean Water Act uses a variety of regulatory and non-regulatory tools to reduce direct pollutant discharges into waterways, finance municipal wastewater treatment facilities, and manage polluted runoff.

The air station's SWPPP directs NAS Key West Environmental Division staff to enforce the following management criteria:

(1) Stormwater runoff is subjected to best management practices (BMP's) prior to discharging into wetlands or surface waters. BMP's shall prevent or reduce the amount of pollution in water to a level compatible with Florida Surface Water Quality Standards;

(2) No site activities result in violation of state water quality standards associated with the saturation of wetlands, or reduction in the natural retention or filtering capability of wetlands; and

(3) Adequate soil erosion measures are implemented. NAS Key West's Environmental Division is responsible for conducting the site compliance evaluations and updating the SWPPP as required.

## DON'T PINE FOR THE PINES

Naval Air Station Key West broke through the glass, or rather, pine ceiling for native plants April 6 when a contractor began removing Australian pine trees behind the barracks buildings that can be seen from U.S. 1. The trees were cut close to the base, sprayed with an herbicide, and stacked for removal. The project was funded by a \$65,000 grant from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection as part of a state-wide effort to rid Florida of this invasive, non-native vegetation. The pines are a fast-spreading, invasive species that can grow very tall and cause serious damage during a storm. They also block out sunlight for native vegetation such as sea grape and button wood trees.

## McNeill's contributions make HAZWASTE program on top for 16 years

### FROM NAS KEY WEST PUBLIC AFFAIRS

When you are stationed in a place like Naval Air Station Key West, you may notice the bright sky, the wildlife, the crystal-clear water and many other beautiful things that catch the eye, but one thing you won't see is hazardous waste. You won't see it because an amazing crew and a great hazardous waste management program have managed to go for not one, not two, but 16 years without a single hazardous waste violation.

NAS Key West's Hazardous Waste management facility is the only "Part B" facility within 150 miles, what that means is that they can store and handle much larger quantities of waste than other local facilities.

"We [NAS Key West] are allowed to collect a lot more waste than any other base around here - we collect hazardous waste from five outlying bases," said Patsy McNeill, an environmental protection specialist for NAS Key West.

To receive and maintain their permit to be a Part B facility the program must pass an annual surprise inspection. The inspection covers every detail of the program from proper paperwork to material that is stored.

"The inspection usually last about three days and

we look at everything; a very major portion of what we look at is their Transfer Storage and Disposal facility - we inspect their storage drums, the facility itself and we look at all their documents," said Edward Russell, an environmental consultant for the Florida Department of Environmental Protection. "They [NAS Key West] have an excellent program and they are always very responsive about environmental issues."

McNeill's replacement will have big shoes to fill come May, however. She retires after 30 years and two months of government service - the last 16 of that as the HAZWASTE manager. She feels that the HAZWASTE program has been a big success because of the way she and her staff train personnel.

"We give you the reasons why not, not just say 'because I told you so,'" she said of teaching the importance of proper handling of hazardous waste.

In her opinion, every little bit of training counts. "We can't make everyone be environmentally conscious, but just a little adds up and it becomes a habit," she said.

McNeill's contributions to the base and the environment won't be forgotten, however. She has donated two Geiger trees, native flowering shrubs, to be planted on base for Earth Day.

## Sea turtles need your watchful eye

Wednesday marked the beginning of the sea turtle nesting season. Potential sea turtle nesting beaches at Naval Air Station Key West include the two beaches at Truman Annex and a smaller beach located by the marina in Boca Chica.

NAS Key West has again organized a volunteer force to monitor the air station's beaches for turtle activity. Each morning, the volunteer walks the beaches looking for any signs of sea turtle nesting in the area and documents any findings.

"You guys are my eyes on the beach," said Carrie Backlund, a Naval Facilities Southeast biological sciences technician, at the sea turtle nesting season volunteer kick-off get-together April 10.

Throughout Florida between April 15 and October 31 female sea turtles break out of their wet home and leave their awkward bodies onto beaches to make their nests. The female sea turtle will dig until they cannot reach any further and then they go into a trance as they begin laying their eggs. A sea turtle can lay more than one hundred eggs at a time and may come back to nest multiple times a season.

After laying, she covers the eggs with sand to camouflage the nest. Then she crawls slowly down the beach until she finally makes it back into the surf and out to sea, never to see her offspring again. The nests incubate in the hot sand for about two months and then, in one mass exodus, usually at night, swarms of little turtles go waddling in a race to the water.

In those few meters of

beach, though, many are picked off by birds, crabs and raccoons. They are not safe once they get in the surf zone, where fish and frigate birds can prey on them. The lucky ones that survive to adulthood (anywhere from 5 - 30 years) will return to the beaches as their ancestors did and repeat the life process.

If you are lucky and happen to see a nesting sea turtle while on the beach, stay behind her at a distance so that she can not see you. Remain quiet and keep all lights off (including flashlights and flash photography). Noise and lights can cause the turtle to return to the sea without laying her eggs. Remember your activities can also affect other turtles nesting in the vicinity. Please keep hands and other objects off and away from the turtle.

After nesting the turtle may appear slow and hesitant. Touching, prodding, shining lights, or causing commotion may frighten her, disorient her, and cause her to spend less time covering and camouflaging her nest. If all goes well she will return to the sea and be on her way.

If you happen to find sea turtle hatchlings on the beach, watch them from a distance. Please allow hatchlings to crawl to the water on their own, as the journey from the nest to the water allows them to imprint on their home beach. Picking the hatchlings up may interfere with this process. Scientists believe the imprinting helps the hatchlings remember where they came from so they can return and lay their own nests 20 - 30 years later. If hatchling turtles see artificial lights they can become confused and may crawl in circles or head away from the ocean.

Janice Giardino, a volunteer beach-walker for the air station and the city beaches, said last year she got to see turtles coming out of their nests.

"To see 120 or so baby turtles hatching, it was amazing," she said. "I've always been an animal lover and it was great."


