The Smithsonian Foreign Currency Program, a national research grants program, offers opportunities for support of research in Burma, Guinea, India, and Pakistan in the following disciplines:

Anthropology, Archeology and related disciplines,
Systematic and Environmental Biology,
Astrophysics and Earth Sciences, and Museum Programs.

Grants in the local currencies of the above listed countries are awarded to American institutions for the research of senior scientists. Collaborative programs involving host country institutions are welcome. Awards are determined on the basis of competitive scholarly review. The deadline for submission is 1 November annually.
