



Mr. Stanley V. Fuller died 30 November 1966 at Malone, Florida. He was born 4 April 1884 in Eastborne, Sussex, England. Mr. Fuller attended Kenelms College in Lewes, Sussex, and studied horticulture in England, Africa, and Australia for 22 years, and later in the United States.

A part time Division of Plant Industry member, and assistant curator of the Lepidoptera Section of the Florida State Collection of Arthropods, Mr. Fuller made hundreds of contributions to the collection. His major contribution came at the time of his death when he willed his personal collection to the state. Some 10,000 pinned, labeled, and identified specimens were donated.
