Investigation of shooting deaths continues

Husband found body outside friend's home

VERNON — The Washington County Sheriff's Office released new details Monday about the circumstances that led to the deaths of two people Sunday morning.

Deputies have been interviewing family members and friends of Shannon Bellew, 36, and Cain Abel Ellis, 27, as well as anyone else who might have come in contact with them in the hours before both were shot and killed Sunday between Vernon and Bonifay.

Rick Bellew, Shannon Bellew's husband, told deputies he had arrived home from a business trip about midnight Saturday and went to Ellis' home at 2152 Pleasant Hill Road to see if Shannon was there, but she wasn't. Shannon Bellew and Ellis had a long-term friendship, according to a release from the WCSO, and had spent the evening before they died driving around in Ellis' vehicle and stopping at friends' homes. They were last seen alive around midnight, according to authorities.

Rick Bellew discovered his wife's body about 8:15 a.m. Sunday in the yard of Ellis' home at 2152 Pleasant Hill Road. Rick Bellew made contact with Ellis before finding his wife dead and contacted the sheriff's office, who arrived on the scene about 10 minutes later. Bellew told deputies Ellis might have been armed, and the Bay County Sheriff's Office SWAT team responded.

SWAT team members responded to a report of an armed man barricaded inside his home and attempted to negotiate, but they never made contact with Ellis, said BCSO Maj. Tommy Ford. Using an armored vehicle equipped with

Unemployment up slightly

The new unemployment figures are in, and there's a slight increase in unemployment in Washington and Holmes counties in comparison to the steady declines that have been occurring over the year.

Holmes County is up to 8 percent for the month of November, in comparison to the 7.6 percent for the month of October. It is an increase of .4 percent, but in comparison to November 2010's 9 percent, it is 1 percent lower.

Washington County is up to 10.7 percent for November, an increase of .4 percent from October's 10.3 percent. Compared to November 2010, which was 12.7 percent, this November is 2 percent lower.

Statewide, Florida's unemployment fell to its lowest mark in 31 months in November, but 10 percent of the workforce remained jobless, state labor officials said Friday.

The November numbers reflected a decrease of four-

tenths of a percentage point from October's revised 10.4 percent unemployment figure. Although November's 10 percent was the state's lowest since May 2009, it remained well above the national average of 8.6 percent unemployment.

The report issued by the newly named Department of Economic Opportunity was largely good news for Florida's Republican Gov. Rick Scott. The self-described "jobs governor" said 120,000 new jobs have been added in Florida since he took office in January and that unemployment has fallen by 2 percentage points in the last 11 months. However, 926,000 Floridians are still trying to find a job. "Florida is moving in

the right direction," said Scott, who returned Thursday from a weeklong trip to Israel that politicians officially described as trade missions, adding that his policies of streamlining government and eliminating regulations that he believes burden businesses are working.

Friday's report showed that 12,300 government jobs, federal, state and local, have been eliminated in Florida this year, although that represents just 1.1 percent of the total in that sector. However, many of the counties with the lowest unemployment were those with relatively high proportions of government jobs.

a ramming device that extends from the front, SWAT was able to assess the situation before entering the home, Ford said.

"I wouldn't say safe, but it gave us a better vantage point to assess the situation," Ford said.

Once inside the home, deputies found Ellis dead from what investigators believe was a self-inflicted gunshot wound.

Bellew was mother to two young boys and stepmother to a teenager, according to one neighbor, who asked not to be named. The neighbor described Bellew's slaying as shocking and sad especially this close to Christmas.

"These are our neighbors," Ellis' neighbor said. "I do have a lot of concern about things happening so close to us and yet not knowing."

"She was a young mother raising a family here," the neighbor said. "I just don't understand what could have happened that would

The trade, transportation and utilities sector has added the most jobs in Florida this year with 35,900. Another 32,700 have been added in private education and health services.

Scott campaigned on creating some 700,000 new jobs over a seven-year period, assuming he'd win re-election in 2014. Since taking office in January, the Republican governor has seen nearly 107,000 new jobs created in the private sector while government jobs continue to go away at all levels.

Monroe County (Key West) reported the lowest unemployment rate, with 6.4 percent of its workforce sidelined, while Hendry County in southwest Florida had the highest at 15.1 percent.

Thirty-two Florida counties reported double-digit unemployment in November.

Notice of Book Closing

Holmes County FL – Debbie Wilcox Morris, Supervisor of Elections announces the "Book Closing" date for January 31, 2012 Presidential Preference Primary Election is January 3, 2012.

By law, Florida is a closed primary state and as such, the PPP is a partisan election for registered Republicans only. Only registered Republicans may request a vote-by-mail ballot for this election. There are no democratic candidates, minor party candidates or amendments on the ballot.

For eligible voters who did not previously request a ballot, they are still available upon request by calling the elections' office at 850-547-1107, by submitting the request in writing or by using the on-line request form on www.holmeselections.com. Written requests must include the voter's date of birth, signature, and Holmes County residence address. Vote-by-mail ballots cannot be forwarded but can be mailed to a temporary mailing address if outside of County. Voters are encouraged to confirm their mailing address when ordering a vote-by-mail ballot. Requests are fulfilled immediately, with ballots being mailed daily. The deadline to request a ballot to be mailed is Wednesday, January 25, 2012.

Voted ballots must be returned to the elections' office by 7:00 p.m. election day, January 31, 2012. Due to the size of the ballot and an envelope re-design, one first-class stamp will be required to return the ballot by mail. Voted ballots may also be hand delivered to the Supervisor of Elections' Office in Holmes County. Voted ballots may not be turned in at the polls on election day.

Written or telephonic requests for vote-by-mail ballots must come from the voter, or an immediate family member or legal guardian on behalf of a voter. Voters may pick up ballots for themselves at the elections' office beginning Wednesday, December 21st, but not for someone else until five days before the election, or Thursday, January 26, 2012. Those picking up ballots on behalf of someone will need a written request from the voter, designating them as the person authorized to carry out the ballot.

The designee will be asked to provide a photo ID and to complete an affidavit before releasing the ballot to them.

Our Diet Has Changed Over The Years

When whoever makes these decisions determined that in the school lunch program, pizza could be called a vegetable, I thought about how our diet and food habits have changed since I was a child. I had never heard of pizza. We didn't know how to pronounce such a thing. As our children were preteens we began to hear of pizza, but the only kind we ever tasted came in a box with the crust mix which we rolled out and opened the can of sauce and spread it on.

It was something the kids could make themselves. The idea that the two tablespoons of tomato sauce one gets from a slice of bread called pizza, counts as a vegetable is ludicrous. But that, along with hamburgers, chicken nuggets, french fries and a carbonated drink make up a meal several times a week for kids today.

I had never had a hamburger until I was a preteen when Perry worked for the Lloyds at Panama City Beach in their little café associated with the beach cabins which they rented. In fact, eating in a café was almost unheard of to me then, and fast food such as McDonald's, came into existence after our children were born. We only ate there when we were traveling or maybe

when we went to the beach, but mostly then we carried a picnic made at home.

As a child, our diet mostly consisted of vegetables. In fact, Daddy used to urge us, even make us, eat some bread, along with whatever else we were having in order, I suppose, to stretch the servings of the main course. When I say bread, I mean corn bread which was made from corn meal made from corn that had been home grown, dried in the crib, hand shucked and then shelled on a hand turned corn sheller. We had a small one in our corn crib that we used to shell enough dry corn to feed the chickens, but for larger amounts such as going to the mill, we went down the lane to Grandpa's house and used his sheller which was bigger.

The other bread which we didn't call bread was called biscuits. Every morning, after my mama built a fire in the wood stove and put water on to boil for coffee and grits, she made a pan full of biscuits which I have never been able to duplicate. With that she cooked cured pork which we just called meat, ham, or smoked sausage from the smoke house. That was pretty much the meat we consumed that day unless we had fish which we usually had on Friday. One would have thought that we were Catholic since there were so many children and we ate fish on Friday. Frequently in the winter, we also ate raw oysters. Mama would

fry a few for sister Minnie who wouldn't eat them raw or make oyster stew for all of us when the supply dwindled to too few for anything else.

On Sunday, we usually had fried chicken which we raised (free range), or beef steak from the town market, pounded with the steak beater, floured and fried in hog lard. In the winter, we ate more meat, the fresh pork which we raised and butchered. But meat was not a part of our daily diet. In fact, when I took home economics in the ninth and tenth grades, one assignment was to make up menus for a week. We only had to include meat for two of the days as that was the recommendation for a healthy diet.

Then, there was gravy. We were talking about this at my Sunday School class luncheon this week. At our home, the dripping from the breakfast meat with a little water added was gravy; some call it red-eye gravy. A bowl of that stayed in the safe all the time. It went on the grits or rice or hot biscuits which we had for breakfast every day. (No store bought cereal) My Aunt Mable from Tennessee called that grease gravy. Then there was milk gravy which we would have for supper sometimes when the left overs from lunch were insufficient to feed the "multitude" as Mama sometimes referred to her cooking chores. Or, we might have tomato gravy for the same purpose. Our neighbor, Verdie Hewett used to make egg gravy

using the old English pronunciation "aig." She called that "pore folks gravy." In addition, gravy from fried chicken or beefsteak, referred to as brown gravy was for putting on mashed potatoes.

Madaline Steverson McFatter said her Mama made fish gravy using canned tomatoes. Our mama made what she called fish gravy which was the drippings in the pan with the leaving of the coating meal browned. No water was added.

At home we really didn't need a plan or a menu. During the summer, we ate peas, field peas which some call black eyes, (My Tennessee aunt called them cow peas.) cream style corn and or corn on the cob, fried okra, boiled okra, and sliced fresh tomatoes with possibly a peach cobbler. In the spring we ate green beans with new potatoes, yellow squash sauted' with onion and cooked till they were brownish which I never liked until I learned to cook them myself with lots of onion. Sliced cucumbers were our salad. Rarely, we also would have fresh

English peas. During fall and winter we would have: turnips, collards and mustard greens with cured ham or fresh pork, and baked sweet potatoes were our diet staples. We always had corn bread made with nothing but salt and water into mama's hand-sized pones was baked in the old black baker with plenty of grease as only a wood fired stove can make it. Home churned butter from our cows was always on the table for the bread or sweet potatoes. But if we got too generous with the butter, we would earn a frown from Daddy.

Green salad which is so popular today was not a part of our diet. We ate raw turnips, raw sweet potatoes, and any fruit we raised such as peaches, pears, plums, satsumas, scuppernongs, watermelons, and cantaloupes.

Today, nutritionists are emphasizing that we eat less meat and more vegetables and fruits. Properly cooked vegetables contain as many if not more nutrients as raw, they say they would certainly not recommend as much fat as we consumed in

our earlier diets, but I suppose the amount of outdoor exercise we got made it O.K.

When I was growing up, French fries was not a part of our vocabulary. Since our potatoes were small home grown, if we fried them they were sliced thinly and fried more like potato chips, though we never had the store bought kind.

When I look at the number of morbidly obese young people today, I wonder how many French fries they ate to get like that.

I wonder if they know how long it will take for their knees to give out carrying that weight. I wonder how long their heart can take the strain. I am glad our First Lady is using her influence to try to stop the increase in obesity rates by training our young children in healthy eating habits. We didn't eat healthily by choice. We ate what was available.

Today's young people do the same. We must do more to train not only the children, but the parents as well.

PET TALK

South American Camelid Basics

Imagine a plateau high in the Andes Mountains covered by nothing but South American camelids and shrubbery. Over the past twenty years, this picture has changed as some South American camelids have found new homes in the United States living very different lives than their predecessors.

The domesticated South American camelids – alpacas and llamas – are sprouting up on farms across the United States. Their intelligence and docile nature make them easy pets for agricultural settings.

Dr. Juan Romano, associate professor at the Texas A&M College of Veterinary Medicine & Biomedical Sciences (CVM), says that South American camelid interest has increased over the years prompting new South American camelid curriculum for veterinary students.

"Alpacas and llamas are the two most common types of South American camelids in Texas," Romano said. "Llamas are larger than alpacas with thicker wool. Alpacas' wool is fine, making it more suitable for sweaters and special suits. Alpacas also have ears that stick straight up, while llamas have ears that fold over like bananas."

Romano says the low-maintenance nature of alpacas and llamas make them viable animals for those with limited agriculture and animal raising experience.

Romano adds that they also make great companion animals, because of their protective nature and their cat-like personality.

"In 2007, the Texas government allowed camelids to be used for livestock purposes, so we saw an influx of South American camelids farm growth then," Romano said. "Today, Texas is one of the most populated states with South American camelids, especially Alpacas."

Prior to starting a South American camelid farm, it is advisable to speak with a veterinarian and do your research. Initial investment varies. South American camelids farm basic requirements are a simple shelter, fencing, forage, clean water, and fiber.

"Eventhough the initial investment may seem feasible, right now it is hard to fund a ranch in the United States, because our prices are not competitive with South American ranches cost of production," Romano expressed. "It is important to do your research and understand the market before you invest in a farm."

It is also important to remember South American camelids' natural habitat before starting a new environment for them. Alpacas and llamas originated from the

high altitudes of the Andes of Chile, Peru, and Bolivia. They were limited to grasslands of shrubbery and weather that is very dry and cold. It is important to try to keep them in an environment their bodies are accustomed to. If not, you can supply their environment with fans, shelter, etc.

"The Texas heat is an issue for alpacas and llamas," Romano explained. "Some regions of Texas are at sea level and it is also very humid. Farmers should supply sprinklers, fans, and shade to avoid heat distress in their animals. Shearing once a year in the spring also helps alleviate heat distress."

South American camelids are familiar with a shrubbery landscape for food. Romano suggests supplying them with

adequatequality fiber found from forage. Owners in the United States tend to overfeedSouth American camelids, because they are used to such limited low quality food sources. Avoid overfeeding to reduce additional health problems.

With expected lifespans of up to 25 years, South American camelids can be a trusted farm companion. Their intellect and obedient nature make them enjoyable pets. However, it is best to do your research prior to investing in a South American camelid as they are not natural inhabitants in the United States landscape. 



Lineup announced for the 34th annual shootout
On Dec. 14, NASCAR announced its most talented lineup for the Shootout in Daytona. The Shootout is the opening event that will launch Speedweeks at the Daytona International Speedway on Feb. 18. The race is set to start at 7:10 p.m. on Fox, and MRN will broadcast the race live.

Eligibility is based on the following qualifications:

The driver has to have been active in the Sprint Cup Series in 2011.

The driver has to be ranked in the top 25 in the 2011 NASCAR Sprint Cup Series.

If not ranked in the top 25, to driver has to be a previous winner at Daytona, including the Daytona 500, Coke Zero 400 or any of the previous Shootout events.
