6) The fishing equipment of a diver may consist of: Diving mask, snorkel, swimming fins, belt, knife, rescue pak, gun and spare twine. Any number of spare parts or equipment may be carried along. Any kind of gun may be used. The use of breathing units and explosive heads on guns is not permitted. Violation of this rule will cause immediate disqualification.

7) No. wave rule.

It is strictly forbidden to wave to each other, unless in an emergency.

#### FISHING AREA

1) The fishing area will be designated on the day of the contest,

shortly before the official opening of each contest.

2) Each official team will have a boat and boatman at its disposal.

#### B O A T S

1) Each team of three (3) persons will have a boat and a boatman at its disposal. This boatman will follow-up closely the instructions of the team's captain. In case of motor trouble, the boatman will signal to a patrolboat from where the operations will be constantly watched.

Spare motors will be available.

2) The boatman can freely aid his team in landing the fish into the

boat, reload guns, etc., but he is not allowed to leave his boat and cannot take part in the fishing whatsoever. Violation of this rule will result in a penalty of 50 points for the team concerned.

3) The divers are allowed to come aboard their boat for a sandwich or a drink, which will be available in all boats, or for a rest. This can take place any number of times in accordance with the instructions of the team's captain.

4) It will be the boatman's duty to be sure that he does not approach another boat within the distance of 50 yards.

5) It will be required of each team to supply their own diver's flag and all other necessary safety precautions.

6) In case divers intend to come aboard their boat, the boatman will see to it that the motor of his boat is put to full stop in order to avoid accidents. In case of accidents or injuries to divers or the boatman himself the latter will signal to the nearest patrolboat and first-aid attendance will be taken care of. Each team should have a 2'x3' orange flag to signal in case of emergency.

7) The boatman will keep in touch with his team and inform the captain about the time to return to the weighing booth.

8) It is strictly forbidden to shoot any kind of fish from the boat. Violation of this rule will cause immediate disqualification.

9) It is to bring a catch ashore at the starting post during the contest, where the catch will be put in a bag, which will be scaled by a member of the jury.

#### THE END OF CONTEST

1) Be sure to return in time to the starting post (14.00).

2) The captain is responsible for the checking time of his team.

3) Teams reporting to the starting post after closing time will be disqualified.

4) Upon return to the weighing booth the team captain will report to the jury with the catch of his team. At least three members of the
