

- make tiffs from DCR files
- cc tiffs

- Photoshop:
 - create screen size jpegs from tiffs
 - approx. 400 px height

- process TIFFs through PreQC through Load

- Image Ready :
 - import jpegs as frames
 - play animation so its smooth

OR

Fireworks:

1. To open a sequence of images in Fireworks, do the following steps:
 1. Choose File > Open
 2. In the open dialog box, select the files in your image sequence, and click Open As Animation. Your images will appear as frames in the Frames panel.
 3. play animation so its smooth

To export an animation to SWF in Fireworks, do the following steps:

1. Choose File > Save As
2. In the Save As dialog box, choose Flash SWF from the Save Copy As pull-down menu.
3. Click Options and change the Flash SWF Export Options according to your preference.
4. Type a file name and click Save.

- Flash:
 - File>new>flash file
 - import SWF to stage
 - in Actions add individual URL for each image
 - document properties (Window > Properties), edit, adjust to contents & make background gray (#EFEFEF) to match UFDC background

Note: Make sure you don't have a frame selected. Click the Stage if you don't see this button.

- check frame rate
- publish preview
- Publish/save
- add SWF to BIB package
- edit package METS
 - add SWF file as "downloads" & label as 360° View
 - add SWF file as "other files"
- FTP entire package again (all tiffs, jpegs, METS, etc) with SWF
- archive entire package with FLA
