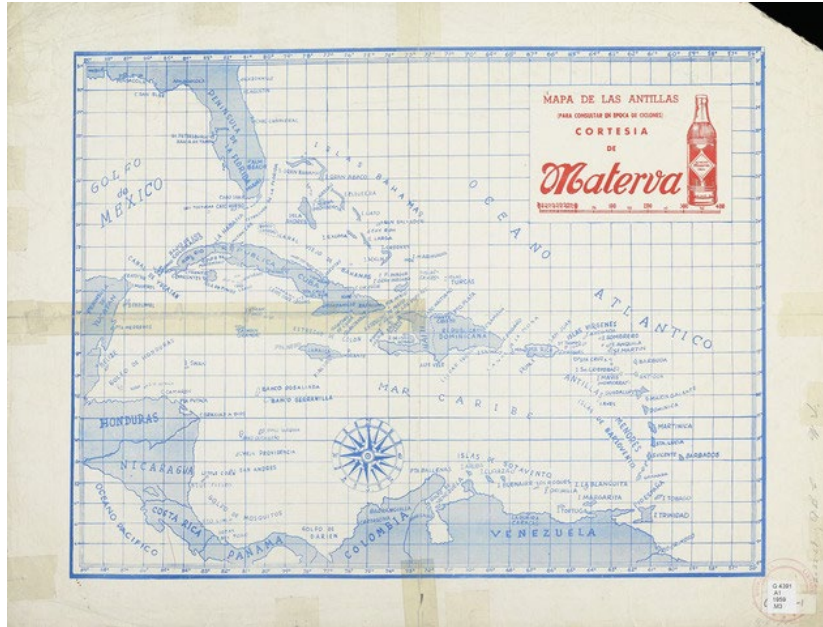
# Questions
