

6. (1) Subject to the provisions of section 11 the nominated members of the Council shall be British subjects of the age of twenty-one years or upwards and shall be appointed by the Governor by Instrument under the Public Seal of the Presidency.

(2) The Governor shall forthwith report to Her Majesty through a Secretary of State every appointment of any person to be a nominated member of the Council.

7. The elected members of the Council shall be persons qualified for election in accordance with the provisions of, and elected in the manner provided by, this Ordinance.

8. After the Commissioner the members of the Council shall take precedence as Her Majesty may specially assign and in default thereof as follows:—

Precedence  
of Members.

First, the official members according to the priority of the Instruments appointing them to be members or, if appointed by the same Instrument, according to the order in which they are named therein;

secondly, persons temporarily appointed under Section 16 to fill vacancies in the number of persons sitting in the Council as official members in such order as the Governor may assign;

thirdly, the nominated and elected members according to the respective dates of the Instruments appointing them or upon which they were declared elected, as the case may be.

If as regards two or more members other than official members such dates coincide, the members shall take precedence—

(a) in the case of two nominated members appointed by the same Instrument, in the order in which they are named therein;
