

67 Senator Amendment: Proposed Constitutional Amendment to Florida Constitution, Voted on (and defeated) at the General Election, November 6, 1956. (1956)

Was #5 on General Election Ballot: 6 Nov. 1956. (SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 7.)
(Legislature of 1955)

"A joint resolution proposing to amend Article VII of the constitution of the state of Florida relating to apportionment of the Senate and House of Representatives." (One Senator for each county)
