## Fish & Game legislation.

One of the great attractions of Florida is its abundant fish and wild life. Mr. Bryant recognizes the need ~~for~~ to protect this valuable resource. Chief among his efforts has been his attempts to ~~to~~ take the Fish & Game Commission out of politics by establishing a merit system for the employees and reducing to statutory powers of the commission.

In order to prevent misuses of our large lakes he voted to make all lakes over 100 acres part of the public domain. He also voted for an appropriation to alleviate the Hyacinth problem which has hurt so much of our good fishing grounds, and voted consistently to help stem the Red Tide menace. He also authorized construction of fishing walks on bridges thus adding to the safety of our fishermen.
