TAMPA --- Farris Bryant, candidate for Governor, arrives in Tampa Wednesday for a two-day whirlwind campaign tour that will include visits to downtown and industrial areas.

At 8 a.m. he is scheduled to attend a breakfast meeting of officials of the American Cross Tie Corp., and area leaders at the Hillsborough Hotel. The occasion will mark the unveiling of a new type product and a new industry for Florida -- pre-stressed concrete railroad ties.

Tampa area shrimp industry workers will meet with Bryant at 11 a.m. at Stoney's Restaurant, Hookers Point.

Warren Cason, local attorney and Hillsborough County manager of the campaign, said Bryant will make two visits to greet prospective voters at the Seaboard Air Line Railroad Shops, 30th Street and Clark, one at 11:30 a.m. and another at 11:30 p.m. Other scheduled Bryant appearances Wednesday include:
