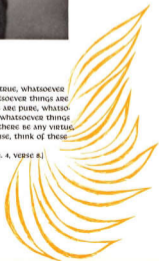

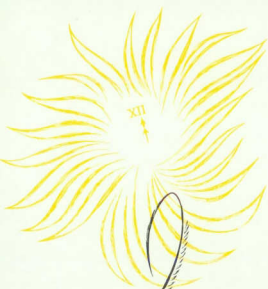

He has been President of Thomas Industrial Institute at Ocala Springs, Supervising Principal of Schools in Ocala and Tampa, and Secretary of Public Relations of the Florida Education Association. He has been President of the Council of Chief State School Officers in the United States and a Director for Florida of the National Education Association.

**DOYLE E. CONNER, Commissioner of Agriculture**, will be the 5th Commissioner of Agriculture in Florida's history when he is inaugurated on January 3. Born December 17, 1926 in Starke, he grew up on his father's general farm in Bradford County. Active in the Future Farmers of America, he was elected State F.F.A. President in 1947, and in 1948-49 was elected National President of the Future Farmers of America. In 1950 while still a sophomore at the University of Florida, Mr. Conner was elected to the House of Representatives. He was elected to two terms while still a student of the University, graduating in 1952 with a BS degree in Agriculture. At the age of 26 he was unanimously elected Speaker of the House of Representatives, the youngest Speaker in Florida's history.
