- May 4, 1947 "Ideas on the March" by Henning Meldt, Miami Herald: "Among freshman representatives who are distinguishing themselves (in Tallahassee) is C. Farris Bryant."
- June 1947 "People in Cracker Politics" by Allen Morris, Tallahassee Bureau, Star-Banner: "The 1947 Legislature's most promising first-termer, C. Farris Bryant, has some rather interesting ideas on the relationship between people and their government. 'Government' says Bryant, 'should never attempt to substitute the philosophies of its agents for the normal development processes of the society upon which it subsists.'"
- Apr. 29, 1949 Jim Massey, Jacksonville Journal: "Ocala's Bryant Wins Spurs as Top Flight Legislator."
- Apr. 30, 1949 "Florida background" by John Kilgore, Orlando Morning Sentinel: "Rep. Bryant has had an excellent record in the House. He is able, alert and has the respect and confidence of the membership and the press."
- May 28, 1949 "Thinking Out Loud" by Joe Grotgut, Daytona Beach Morning Journal: "Rep. C. Farris Bryant has proved (himself) conscientious and consistent young legislator."
- Oct. 30, 1949 Morty Freedman, St. Petersburg Times: "Bryant--courageous, forthright and sincere...consistently on the right side... has the ability to dissent logically."
- May 27, 1950 "Palm Tree Politics" - Tampa Times. "Farris (Bryant) is one Florida's most able young politicians. He was outstanding in the 1949 session in the fight for economy." ✓
