What little I was able to do for you in your recent campaign was based upon my belief that you would make Florida the best governor it has ever known. I have not sought your company because I know that there are many others whom you must see.

I have not requested favors because I do not feel entitled to them. I have not sought to influence your judgment except in what I considered to be your behalf. I shall attempt to follow these rules in our dealings after you occupy the Governor's chair in Tallahassee.

I am unalterably opposed to the appointment of Perrine Palmer for reasons which I believe are also known to Carl G. Rose.
