Dear Frank:

Congratulations on your good financial work. Sometime I would like to hear from you what kind of fellow Sheppard Broad is--I have never met him, but have heard a good deal about him.

The program of the Iowa Citizenship Clearing House is an extremely interesting one. It seems to me that a determination of the particular Congressman selected to do this job would involve a review of his housing facilities. It seems to me also that the Republican students should go to visit with Mr. Cramer, and the Democratic students with a Democratic Congressman. I would be very happy for my son, if I had one, to visit either with Charlie Bennett, Billy Matthews, Sid Herlond, Paul Rogers, or Danny Pacell--or indeed with any of the other Florida Congressmen--but believe that Paul Rodgers is the one most likely to be receptive to such a proposition. My recollection is that he is a bachelor and therefore would inconvenience no one but himself.

If you would like for me to do so I will explore this proposition on an informal basis with one or more of the Congressmen the next time I run into them(which won't be far off) and let you have a report on it.
