Dear Mr. Graham:

As you are doubtless aware the Legislature of 1951 in its appropriation for the Minimum Poundation Program included capital outlay funds for the entire blennium of 1951-1953. The blennium runs until June 30, 1953.

There was also submitted to the electorate Constitutional Amendment Number One which provided, among other things, that beginning January 1, 1955, certain proceeds should be act aside in the County Capital Outlay and Debt Service School Fund in the State treasury.

It thus appears that by the terms of the appropriation and mannedment there may be a duplication of appropriations for the aix months period immuney let-lowe 50th, 1953, a duplication that was nower intended. I recall vagardy discussing that with members of the Department of Education at the time the American at that time that in the event the Americans was adopted that that the that in the event the Americans was adopted the duplication would not be permitted. So far as I more that is still their satisface.

Mevertheless, should there ever be a request at any session

of the Budget Gometasion for release of funds under the Minisma Promisition Programs appropriation which would result in a duplication for the six months period sentioned or entering the six and the proposition of the continuous propositions, I would very mean appropriation for the consistency of the continuous newer intended either by the Legislature in measing the Minisma Promision Programs appropriation or by the people in adopting the Amendment Number Comp. and that the funds under the service should be selected as the six of the service should not be released.
