Dear Farris:

The operating budget for the next fiscal year must be in the hands of the Budget Director by June 1st. Enclosed is a memorandum containing my recommendations relating to the salary portion of this budget. I know you will want as much time as possible to study these recommendations and decide upon your position in the matter. The expense portion of the budget and the budget for educational television will be forwarded before the end of the month.

I have an appointment with Mr. Emery of the Joint Committee on Educational Television to discuss some of the problems raised by the conclusions reached at the meeting in Jacksonville. It will also be necessary for me to determine from the F.C.C. whether or not your plan for an advisory committee to the Program Production Center will violate the rule of the F.C.C. that each franchise holder be solely responsible for the operating policies of the station. We are proceeding with the other data and our report should be ready for submission to your committee about the 1st of June.
