

Bryant Is Planning To Quit U.S. Job

ASHEVILLE, N.C., Sept. 11 — Farris Bryant, director of the U.S. Office of Emergency Planning, disclosed today that he plans to resign before the end of the year.

The 53-year-old former Florida Governor told the Southern Governors Conference here that he plans to return to his law practice and not re-enter politics despite speculations that he might run for the Senate next year.
